APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Surface Preparation

- 1. Ensure the surface is clean, dry, and free from dust, grease, or old flaking paint.
- 2. If applying over previously painted surfaces, remove non-breathable coatings for best adhesion.
- applying lime wash to improve absorption.

Application

- 1. Apply with a wide brush in thin, even coats using crisscross strokes for texture.
- 2. Allow **12-24 hours** of drying time between coats.
- 3. For best results, apply 2-3 coats to achieve depth and coverage.
- 4. Keep the surface lightly damp during application to prevent rapid drying and cracking.

Technical Details

- Composition: Slaked lime, natural minerals, and pigments
- Color: cement
- Drying Time: Touch dry in 1-2 hours, fully cured in 2-3 days
- Coverage: 25 meters per pail
- Water Resistance: fully waterproof
- Shelf Life: 12 months if stored in an airtight
